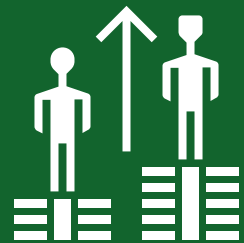


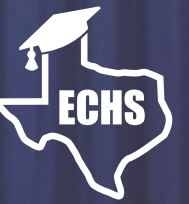

Bryan Collegiate in Bryan ISD partners with Blinn College to offer students a unique Early College High School (ECHS) experience. The school has been serving students with the ECHS model since 2007. Bryan Collegiate students take all their 9th and 10th grade courses at Bryan Collegiate; Blinn College sends instructors to the high school campus to teach. In their 11th grade year, students split their time between the high school and college campus. Bryan Collegiate seniors are enrolled as full-time college students, taking all their courses at Blinn College. This intentional blending of high school and college instills commitment to postsecondary education and increases motivation for students to continue their higher education path. Tuition, books and supplies are provided at no cost to the students. Since approximately 71% of Bryan Collegiate’s student population is designated economically disadvantaged, many of these students may not have had the opportunity to attend college without the ECHS program.

In addition to preparing students for college success, Bryan Collegiate creates a foundation for thoughtful citizenship by instilling a strong sense of service. The school requires each student to complete 100 hours of community service to be completed by the end of their senior year. Bryan Collegiate also invests considerable time and programming to develop their students’ social-emotional skills. Within groups called “families,” students explore topics that young people often struggle with, such as bullying, suicide, dating and stress-management.



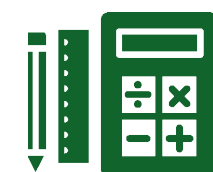
