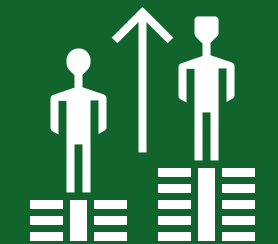

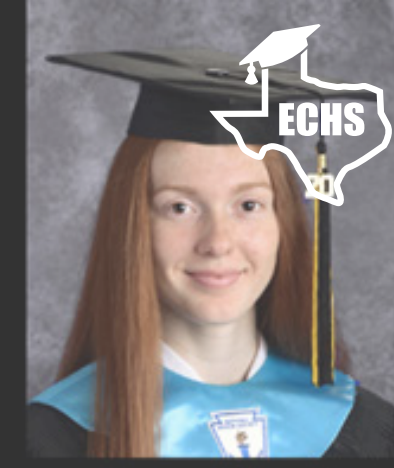

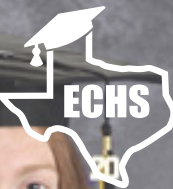

TEXAS COLLEGE & CAREER READINESS SCHOOL MODELS

A rural school outside of Austin in Bastrop ISD, Colorado River Collegiate Academy has developed an ECHS program distinguished by exceptional student support. The school has been serving students with the ECHS model since 2014. From the counselors, teachers and administration to the ECHS program specialist, students receive personalized attention and guidance. The school's College Access Specialist, who has a mental health counseling background, drives the ECHS students back and forth from IHE partner Austin Community College each day. While the students take their dual credit courses, the specialist stays on the college campus and confers with the collegiate advisors and professors to track student progress. This daily check-in enables the College Access Specialists to work closely with the students to help them in areas of growth, personal challenges and academic planning. The Academy utilizes Fridays at its own campus for intervention opportunities.

Principal Conrardy leads both the Academy and the adjoining Genesis High School for students who have dropped out or have had other academic issues. He believes that a high level of student involvement leads to student success, as the campus has demonstrated for seven years with the ECHS program. A testament to the commitment of their students and staff, 38 out of 44 Colorado River Collegiate Academy ECHS students are earning their Associates degrees this year, and six ECHS seniors are graduating despite having no internet access during the COVID-19 school shutdown.
